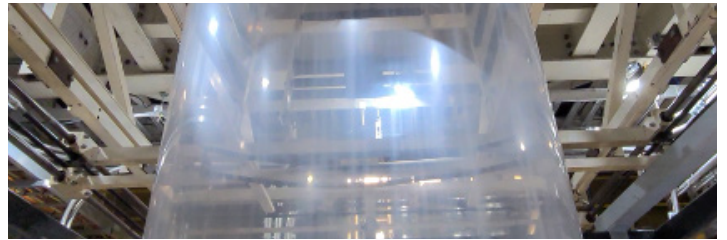

Food Safety Certification Programs

SQF (Safe Quality Food)

- Requires a trained staff member experienced in SQF process.
- Intensive training of all personnel.
- Recognized within the food industry as the highest standard and the one most food processors are certified in.
- Meets 100% of FSMA requirements.

BRC (British Retail Consortium)

- Does not require a trained designee.
- Training is not as diligent as SQF, nor is it required.
- Primarily based on retail establishments.
- Meets 80% of FSMA requirements.

AIB (American Institute of Baking)

- Does not require a trained designee.
- Training is required of all personnel.
- AIB standard is not a GFSI standard. Majority of food processors no longer accept AIB as a 3rd party audit.
- Meets less than 80% FSMA requirements.

Global Food Safety Initiative (GFSI) is the governing body of SQF and BRC.
